

# Johnson County Business Community

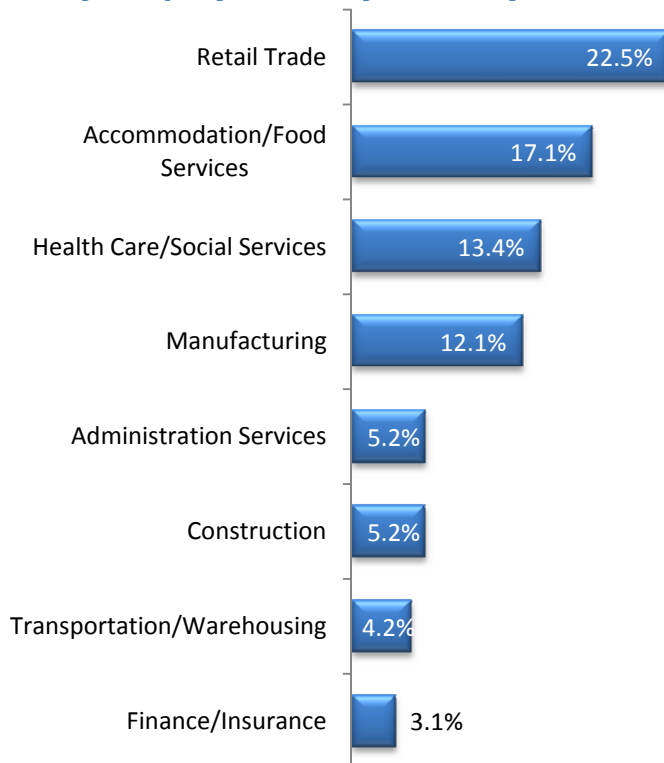
