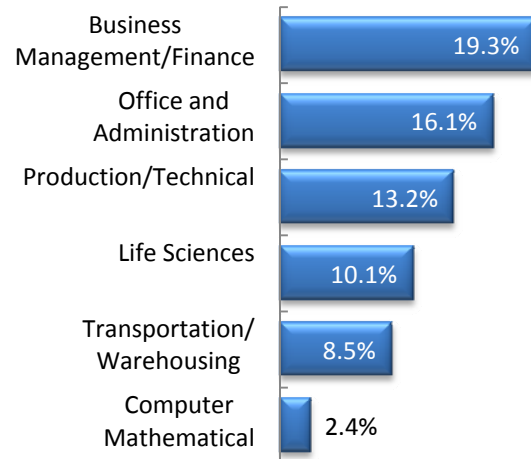


# Indianapolis Region Workforce



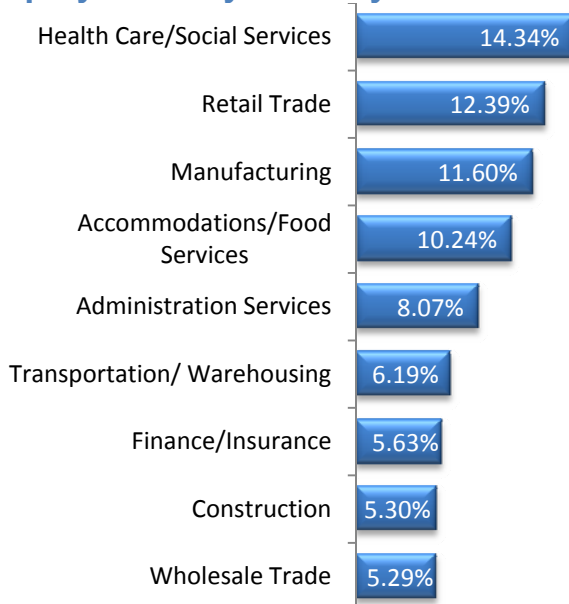
